End-of-life care is extremely complex. The hospice team is composed of specially trained staff and volunteers who can provide comprehensive medical care

A place requiring a "Do Not Resuscitate" status prior to admission.

Medicare-certified hospices do not require a DNR order, since it is understood by the patient and family that the patient will be receiving palliative, not curative, care.

A philosophy of "nothing more can be done."

When a cure is no longer an option, there is still a great deal that can be done to control symptoms, and provide care, comfort and support. Hospice care is the model of high-quality, compassionate care that helps patients and families live as fully as possible.
